- Recovery

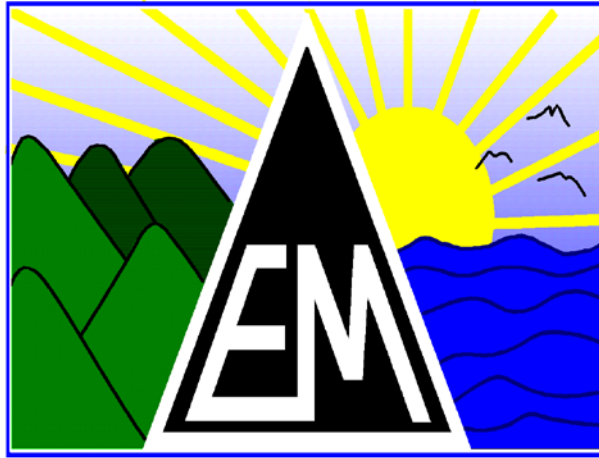
- Support Recovery Efforts within the Region
