**SUBJECT:** EMS Agency Staffing Concerns

**DATE:** August 5, 2021

Current data shows that COVID trends are quickly increasing, with staffing remaining a top concern for EMS agencies across the State. These unprecedented times require us all to think outside the box to effectively manage this situation. We realize that each EMS Agency has multiple challenges that make managing these issues very complex. We wanted to share several strategies to consider implementing within your agency as resources allow:

- Incentivize staff to cover additional shifts
- Alternative transportation methods for non-emergency transports (i.e. Uber, Lyft, Taxi, etc.)
- EMD triage of non-emergency calls to utilize alternative resources after appropriate screening of patient with oversight of Medical Director
- Implementing or expanding telemedicine services
- Contracting backup 911 services or transport with traditional NET providers
- Implementing 131E-158 system waivers allowing for one credentialed person on ambulances, utilizing non-credentialed personnel as drivers

Additionally, NCOEMS HPP is working with the Healthcare System to try and strategize on additional methods to alleviate the medical surge within the hospitals. Our goal is to provide some improvement to turnaround times and diversion concerns where possible.

This pandemic has shown the world the importance of EMS as a true partner to all of healthcare and we must protect our own people so that we can meet the needs of the public during their worst moments.
