
# EHPC 2022 COMMUNICATION AND INFORMATION SHARING EXERCISE (FUNCTIONAL VIRTUAL)

#### Are you prepared for hurricane season? The time to exercise is now!

#### **Overview**

This exercise is designed to give public safety, healthcare, and auxiliary communication groups an opportunity to work from their home base or agency while exposing them to current communication challenges, plans, and capabilities. This exercise is not meant to evaluate any one particular agency or group. Instead, it is designed to show functional strengths and gaps for future training and exercise needs. This exercise is timed to ensure regional and statewide partners are prepared for the 2022 hurricane season. This is an HSEEP compliant exercise and agencies can receive EMPG credit for participation. A minimum amount of objectives need to be completed in order to qualify for credit.

#### **Public Safety - Healthcare**

Public Safety and Healthcare agencies will work on objectives designed to challenge their specific disciplines. This is a self-paced virtual exercise. All tasks require some type of measurable response (interacting with the local, regional, or statewide partners). Exercise play will be low stress and a positive learning environment.

# **Auxiliary Communications**

Auxcomm personnel will work on objectives targeted towards EMCOMM. Auxcomm personnel are encouraged to work with their local Emergency Managers, EOCs, and RCC. Various pathways on communicating with the Regional Coordination Centers (RCC's) will be exercised. Auxcomm personnel will be challenged to use various pathways that are currently identified for regional and statewide communications.
