## Purpose of HSGP (from U.S. DHS)

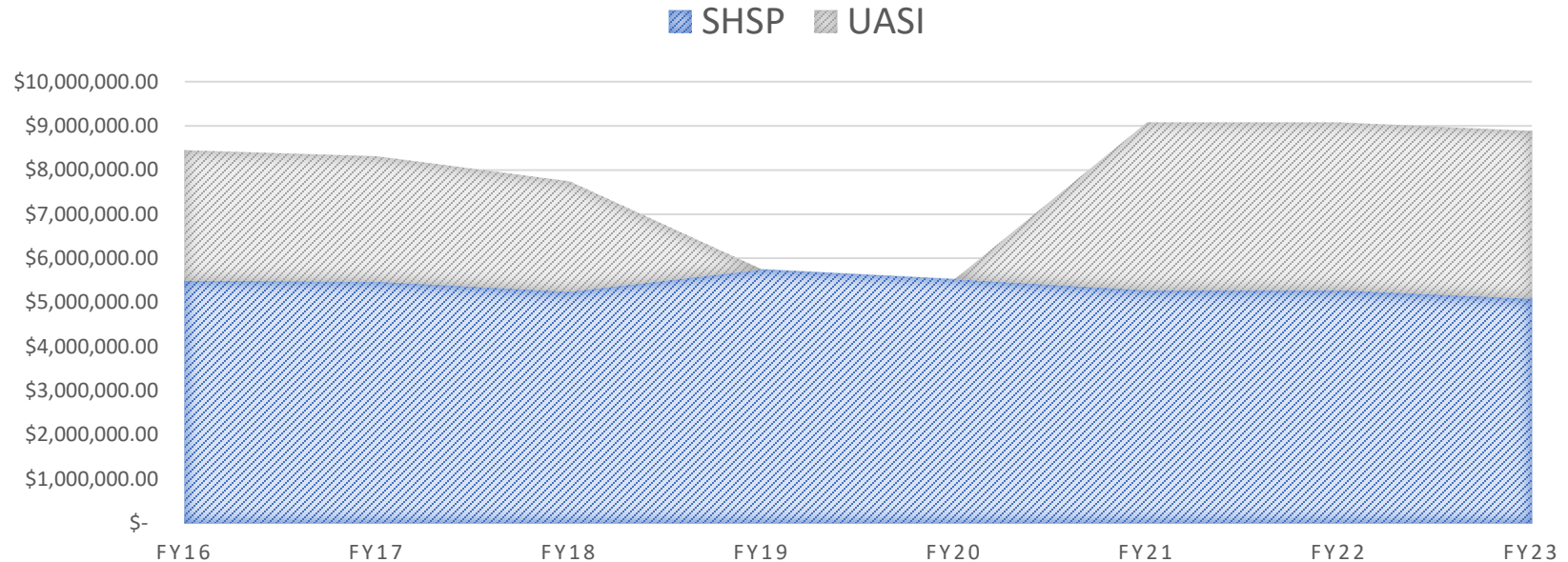
“To enhance the ability of State, Local, tribal and territorial governments, as well as nonprofits, to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from terrorist attacks. “
