Hospital Diversion

Eastern Healthcare Preparedness Coalition Hospital Diversion and Facility Disruption Notifications

This process is for use by designated staff to notify regional partners when a hospital needs to go on Diversion and/or has experienced a disruption in normal operations. Diversion and disruptions can be caused by surges in patients, staffing shortages, critical clinical components (CT, MRI, OR) and/or critical infrastructure failures as well as catastrophic damage from fire, wind, and water.

Once the decision is made to activate the Diversion or Disruption response, local and regional stakeholders need to be notified of the situation in order to initiate alternate plans.

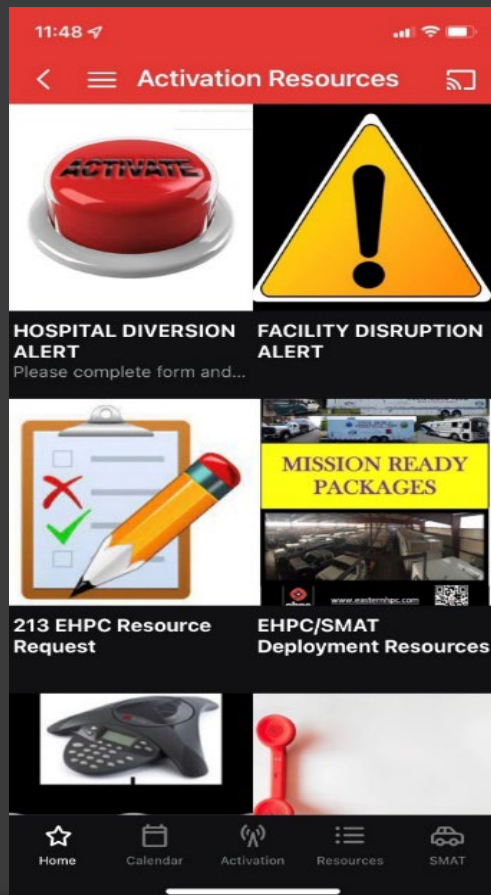
To activate a diversion in the app, click on **Activation Resources**, then choose **Diversion** or **Facility Disruption Alert** icons.

Fill out the form and click submit.

If you select **Yes – Full Diversion**, you must submit a follow up form **every 4 hours**.

If you select **Yes – Partial Diversion**, you should submit a subsequent form at **each shift change*** until the diversion is cleared.

**For long term Partial Diversions, submit forms only for status updates.*

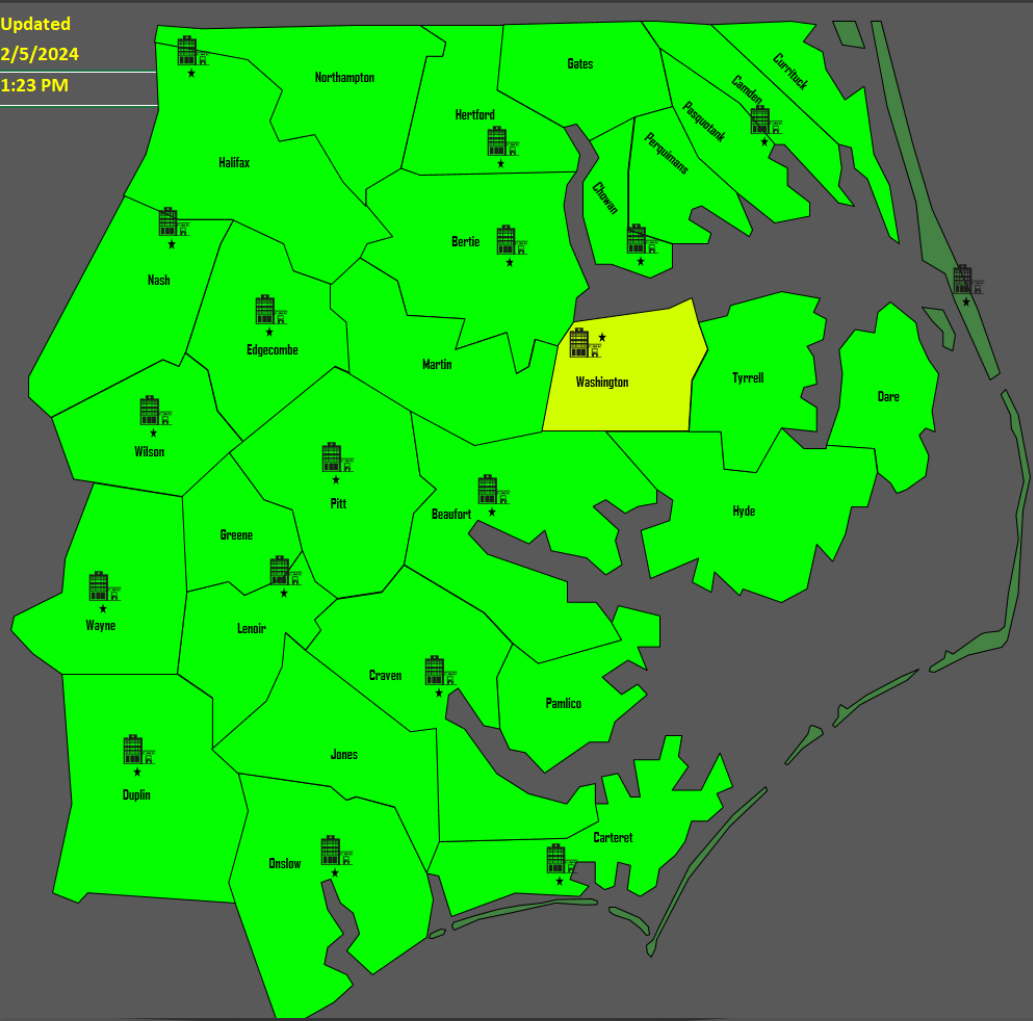

REGIONAL HOSPITAL DIVERSION AND DISRUPTION DASHBOARD

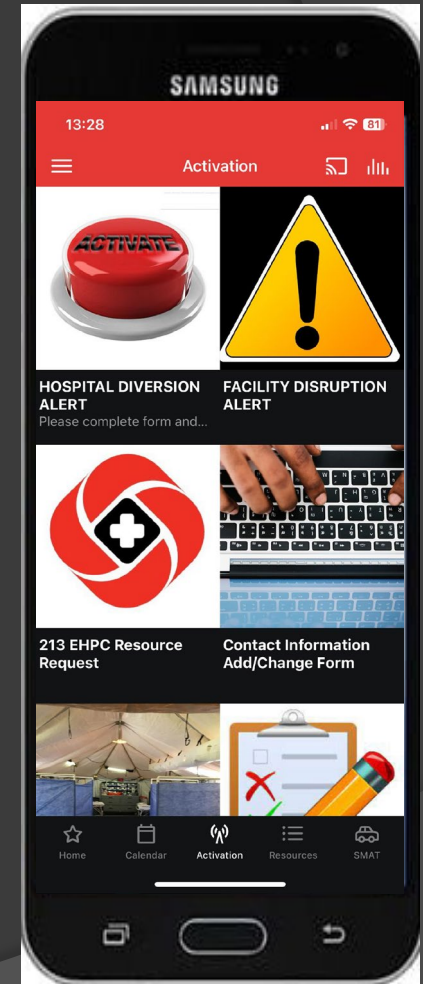

STEADY LIGHT		FLASHING LIGHT	
RED	Rapid Charge: Battery is in rapid charge mode	RED	The battery is unchargeable or not making proper contact.
ORANGE	Reconditioning Mode: Your battery is in reconditioning mode. However long your battery remains in this mode depends on the remaining charge of your battery. Fully charged batteries require more time than fully discharged batteries.	ORANGE	The charger has recognized your battery but is waiting to charge. Voltage or Temperature could be too high/low. When corrected, the battery will start charging.
GREEN	Fully charged: Your battery has completed its charge	GREEN	The battery has completed a rapid charge. The battery is now in top-off charge
		RED & GREEN	Battery is fully charged. Battery continues to be usable but may be nearing end of service life.

HOW TO START RECONDITIONING MODE

MANUALLY

Insert your battery into the charger, and within the first 2.5 minutes, remove and insert the battery within 5 seconds. This will manually start the reconditioning process. The charger should change from steady RED to steady ORANGE




AUTOMATICALLY


There is no need to do anything. IMPRES chargers are designed to know when its time to start the reconditioning process. When it needs to be reconditioned, the charger will show a steady ORANGE. When it's done reconditioning your battery, the charger will start recharging the battery.

STOP RECONDITIONING

To stop the reconditioning process, remove and reinsert the battery within 5 seconds. This will end the recondition process and start charging. It should now show a STEADY RED.

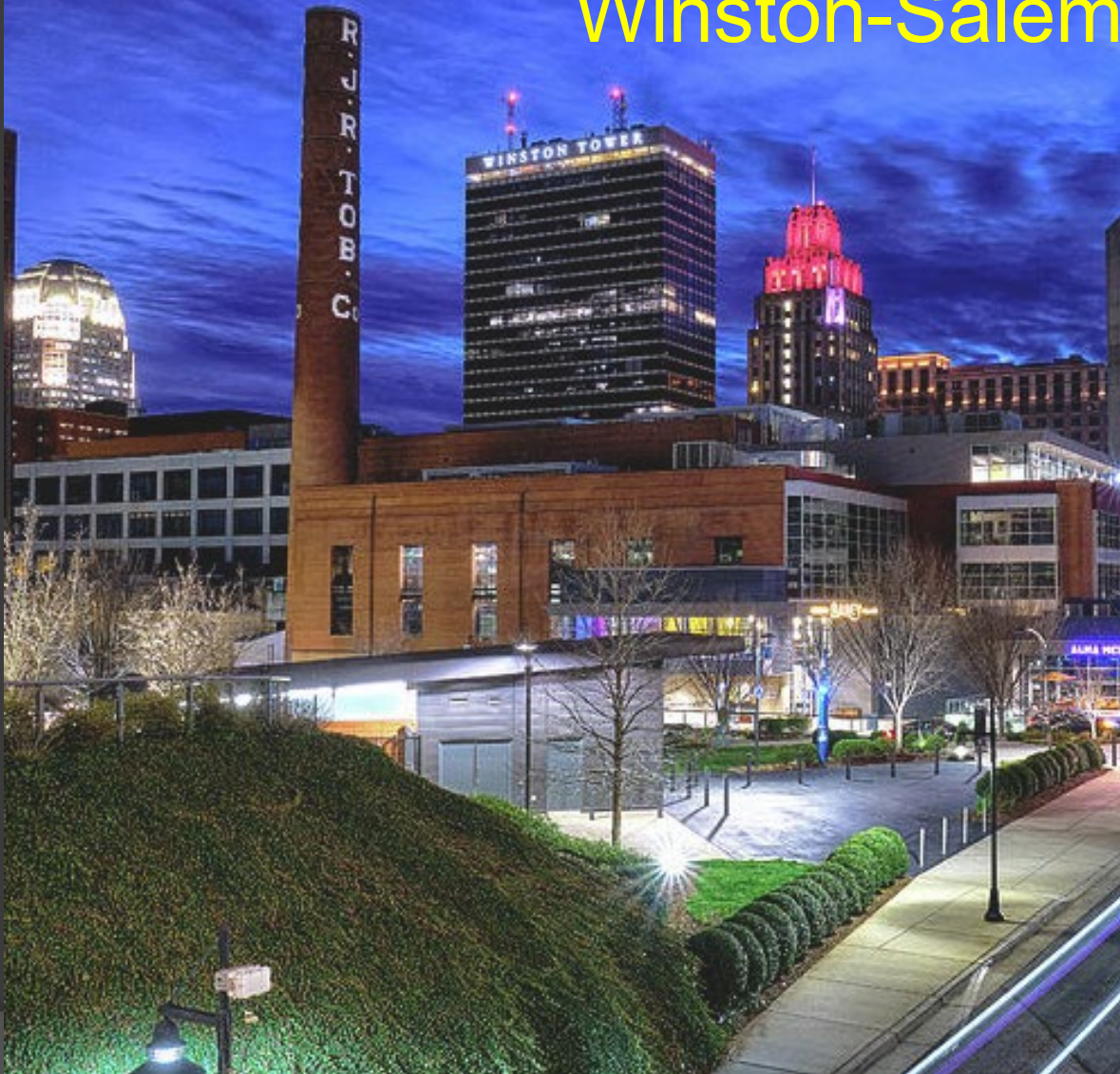




